



## The Future of Jonathan Carver Parkway

### Construction Planned for 2021

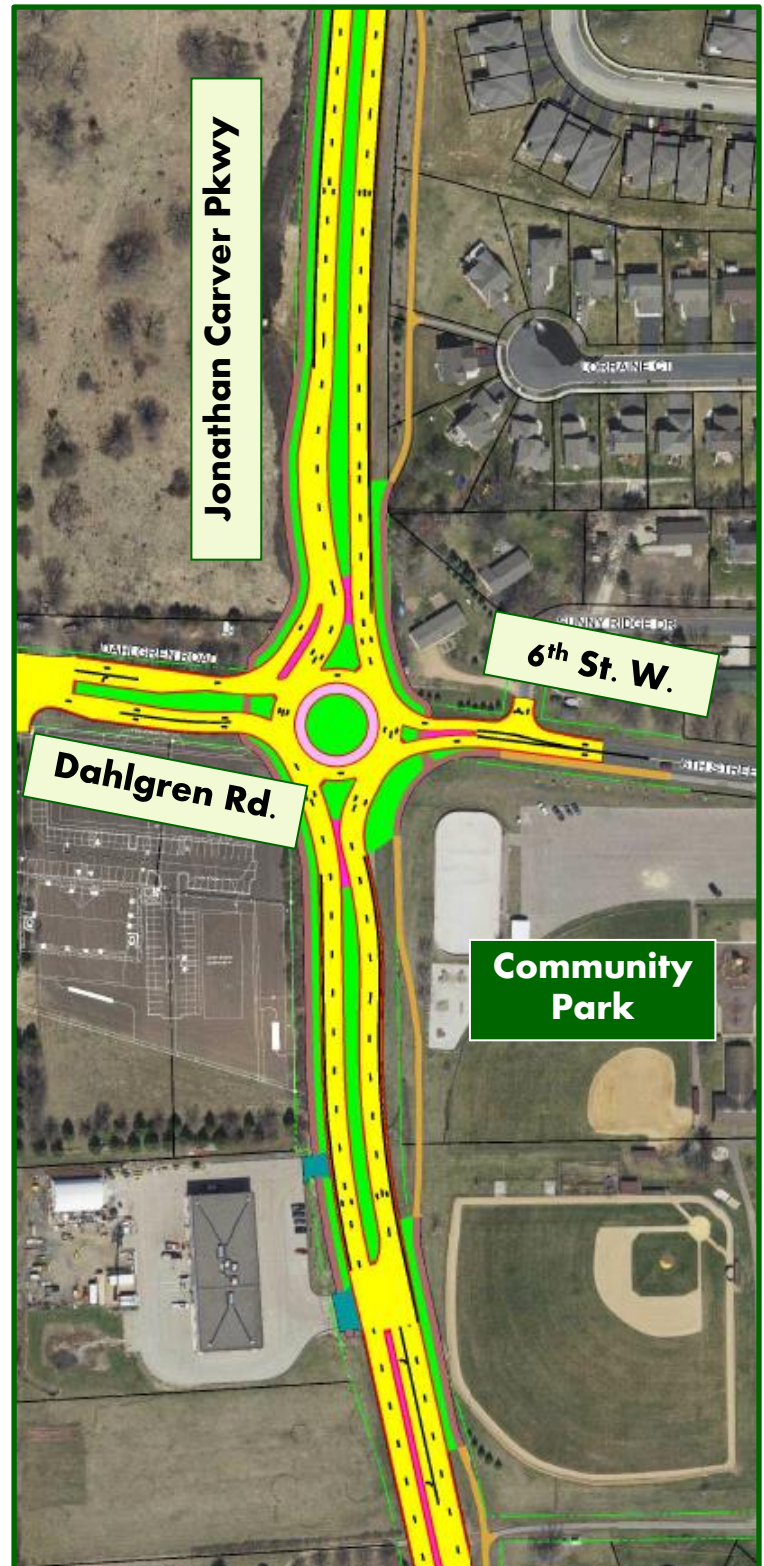
A plan for the future of Jonathan Carver Parkway, also known as Carver County Road 11, has been developed after two years of meeting with neighborhood leaders, business owners, and emergency services personnel. The process also included several community open house events with residents.

The City Council identified the need to study the future of Jonathan Carver Parkway (JCP) during their 2015 strategic planning session. The City of Carver and Carver County shared the cost of the study, which was performed by WSB, an engineering firm from Golden Valley. WSB focused on the following critical topic areas:

- Amount and timing of development along the corridor
- Levels of motor vehicle traffic
- Congestion at intersections
- Safety
- Pedestrian and bicycle connectivity
- Spacing and intersection control
- Environmental impacts

After several months of investigation and feedback from stakeholders, a recommendation has been made to make several improvements along the JCP corridor. First, expand JCP to four lanes from 6<sup>th</sup> St. W. to Levi Griffin Rd. Second, construct a second pedestrian underpass below JCP. The pedestrian underpass would be located north of Carver Elementary, eliminating the need for students to cross JCP at Ironwood Drive.
