



Mayor's Message

Greetings! I hope this note finds everyone doing well and staying cool, now that summer is officially in full swing and the weather is HOT!

Last month the City of Carver had to institute a temporary emergency outdoor watering ban, which coincided with a record-breaking hot temperature streak. The reason for the temporary ban was because the pump in one of our wells broke. With the well not functioning, we had to put the watering ban in place to ensure there would be an adequate water supply and enough water pressure, should the fire department need it to fight a fire in our community.



Even though the City of Carver has four wells, when one of them goes down during the peak summer usage time, it's a significant risk to the City's water supply. Water usage in Carver spikes by approximately 1 million gallons/day during the summer months when folks are watering their lawns and gardens.

With Carver's growth, we are quickly reaching the 1.3 million gallons/day maximum capacity of the current facility. The City of Carver is investing in an expansion project to Carver's Water Treatment Facility, which will give the City of Carver an additional 1.5 million gallons/day capacity, more than doubling our water supply capabilities.

I appreciate everyone who followed the restrictions of last month's temporary emergency outdoor watering ban and appreciate everyone's patience while we waited to have the well pump repaired. Thank you!

Finally, I have some really good news to share! Last month, we learned the City of Carver won a Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) grant from the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT). With this grant, the City of Carver will receive up to \$1.25 million for construction on 6th Street West. This project will include full depth pavement reclamation, enhancements to the storm sewer system to alleviate localized flooding, and pedestrian and bicycle mobility improvements along the corridor. Construction on 6th Street will take place next year.

These decals may be picked up at Carver City Hall during regular business hours.


Stage 2 Closure Local Access Routes

Business access route


Key access route to the Carver Square businesses


Carver Square Access from the North
