

6TH STREET WEST IMPROVEMENTS



CONSTRUCTION BEGINS THE WEEK OF JULY 25

Beginning the week of July 25, construction will begin along 6th Street West. Improvements include rebuilding the roadway, improving the storm sewer network and upgrading the pedestrian facilities along the corridor. Other updates will be made at this time to enhance the functional uses, safety and visual quality of the corridor, such as striped bike lanes, additional lighting and adjustments to key intersections.

SCHEDULE



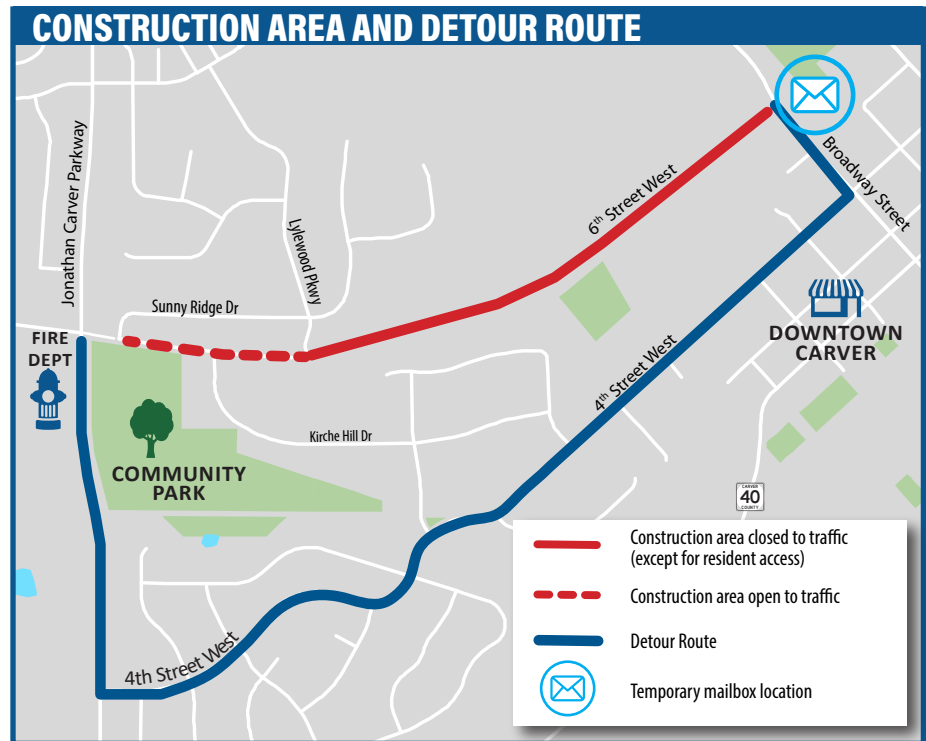
Construction will begin the week of July 25 and is expected to last into Fall 2022, with minor work to be completed in Spring 2023.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Contractors typically work from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, with some Saturdays.

During working days, there will be noise, mud, dirt piles, dust and other construction-related activities. While it is not possible to mitigate all of these issues, the contractor will try to limit these disturbances as much as possible, including spraying the road to control dust and filling in and grading muddy areas.



ACCESS IMPACTS



Impacts to property access will occur throughout construction, but roadway and driveway access will be maintained to residents adjacent to the project, by the end of the work day and throughout construction. Please note that if school bus routes are impacted by construction, the bus company will be reaching out to homeowners.

GARBAGE COLLECTION



Residents within the closure area should have garbage cans at the end of their driveway by early morning of garbage pick up days. The contractor will move the cans to a central pickup location if site access for garbage trucks cannot be maintained. The garbage cans will then be moved back to the ends of driveways by the end of the work day.

TEMPORARY MAILBOXES



Please note that residents within the construction area closed to traffic will have temporary mailboxes installed during construction. See map above for temporary mailbox location. Service to these mailboxes will begin on Monday, July 25.
