
Housing

“Homes for All” is one of the key planning principles guiding the 2040 Comprehensive Plan, ensuring that Carver is a community that people at all stages within their life-cycle can call home.

Carver is projected to have 3,630 households by 2030, and 5,600 households by 2040. This represents an additional 4,192 households between now and 2040, which is about a five-fold increase in the population.



Senior housing has been identified as a type of housing that will be in strong demand as new homes are constructed. This will provide diversity in the housing available within the City, and allow new families more options for purchasing homes in existing neighborhoods.

Upcoming Schedule

The City Council and Planning Commission will be meeting jointly each month to prepare the plan and consider ideas received. The meetings are open to the public and locations and times are posted on the City’s website.
