

Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC)



The Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) meets the second Tuesday of each month at Carver City Hall at 6:00 p.m. to review, to approve, and to give assistance to contractors, to business owners, and to home owners that propose exterior alterations to properties that are located in the Historic District. The Historic District has over 100 structures within its boundaries that are listed with the National Register of Historic Places.



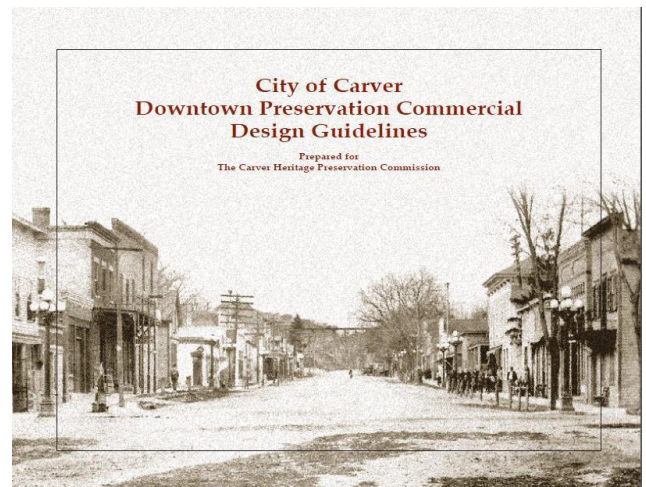
The Carver Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) is responsible for monitoring changes to those properties within the Historic District. Preservation is essentially retaining and properly maintaining the existing historic aspects of a building.

All exterior alterations must be presented to the HPC for their review.

Staff has fifteen (15) business days to review the application for completeness. The following items need to be submitted to City Hall to be on the monthly agenda:

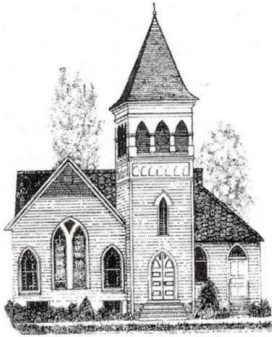
- A completed Application for Historic Property Alteration.
- Plans that show specific proposed changes to the structure or property.
- Pamphlets/brochures on products or materials that will be proposed.

If a property owner is unsure if a property is located within Carver's Historical District, or is unsure if the project needs to be reviewed by the HPC, they should contact City Hall at 952-448-5353.
